InTouch Health's 3G Mobile Broadband Solution Judged Best Implementation in Healthcare

Using Remote Presence, physicians can consult with patients and staff more readily and frequently, thereby improving physician efficiency, hospital throughput and quality of care. With the capability of EV-DO Rev. A technology, physicians can maintain personal attention to their patients while being away from the hospital.
